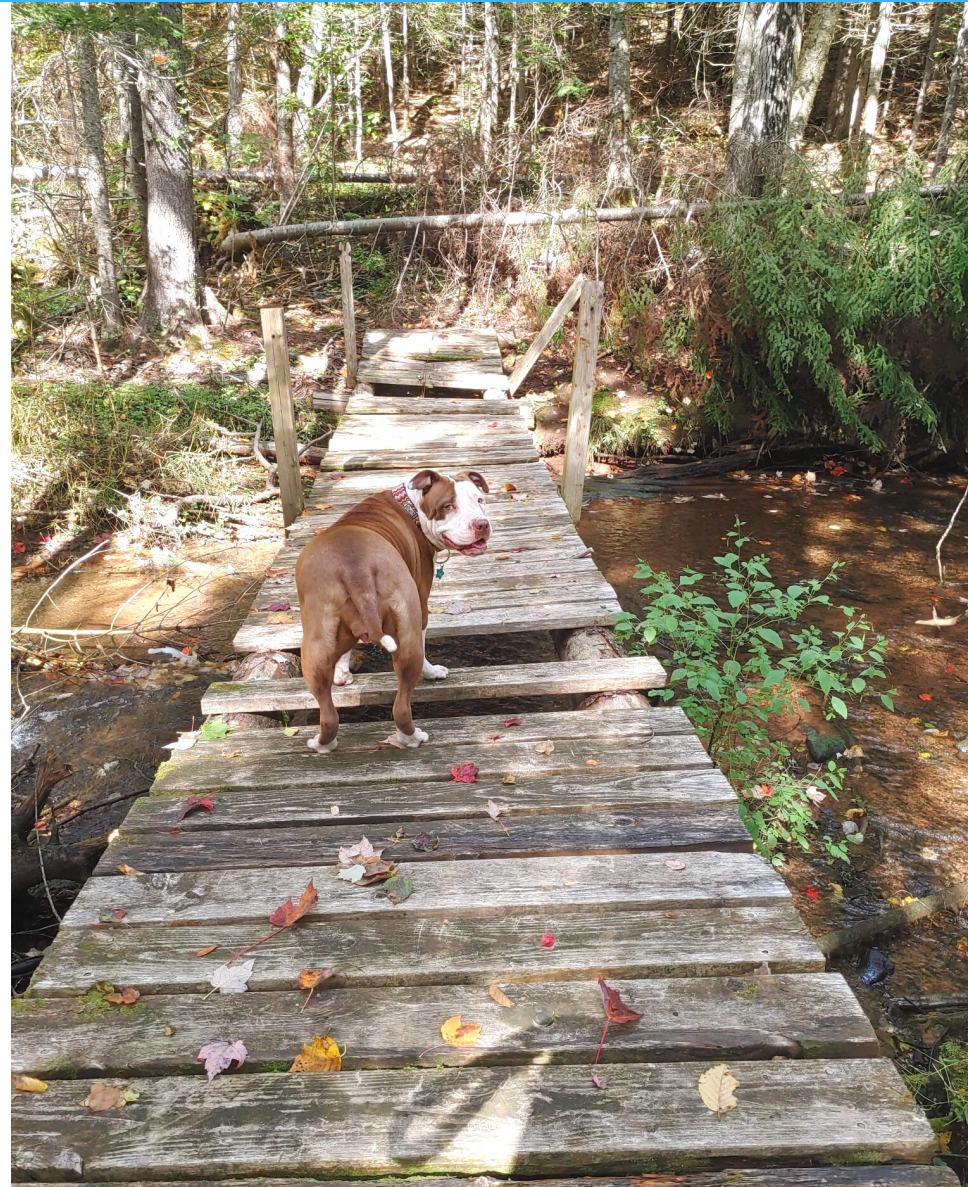

GIBSON'S LEGACY: ADOPTION REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum 18 years of age, employed/retired/disability.
- Owns home. If renting, written landlord consent is required prior to adoption.
- Submit application in full.
- Enroll and purchase mandatory training package as per the recommendation of the rescue.
- Proof of purchase of Pet Insurance for the the animal.
- The animal is adopted as a family pet, will sleep indoors and will be a member of the family.



GIBSON'S LEGACY: ADOPTION F.A.Q

Q. What is the cost of adoption?

A. \$500.00 (Intact Dogs: Cost of Spay/Neuter is additional; it is to be scheduled and paid for at the time of adoption, with proof of payment required.)

Q. Can I come see the dogs?

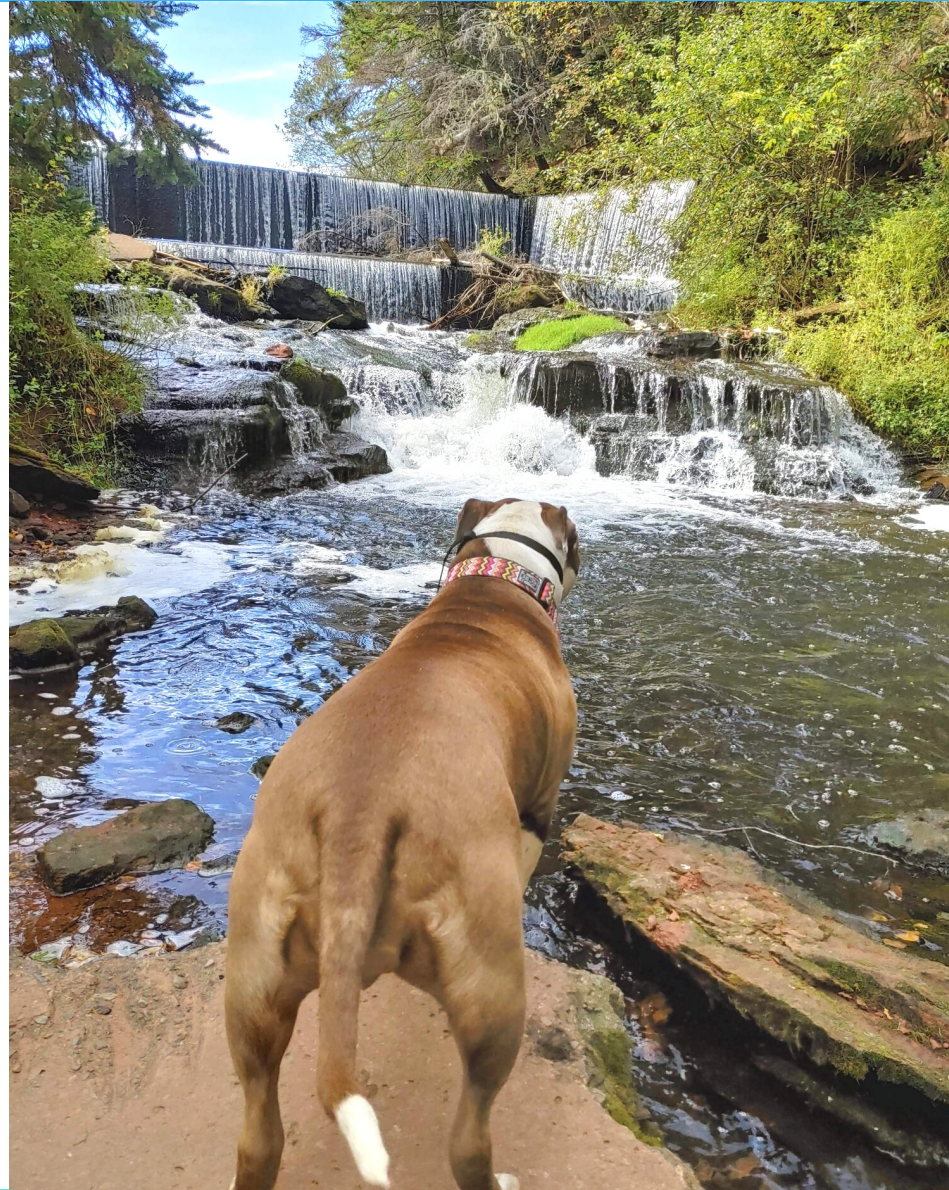
A. Once pre-approved you may come meet the dogs most suited to you. We will contact you about the best fitting dog to your adoption profile.

Q. None of the current dogs seem like a good fit, can I still become pre- approved to adopt?

A. Yes! Please submit an application, in the "Dogs Name" field, just let us know you are waiting for the perfect fit. We will contact you when that dog comes along!

Q. If approved for the dog, when can I take him/her home?

A. Once approved for the adoption of a dog, you will go through a 5-day Trial Adoption, just to make sure everything is a perfect match. After the five days, adoption fees and forms are processed.



THINGS TO HAVE FOR YOUR NEW DOGS ARRIVAL

- Kennel and Blanket(s)
- Food/Water Dishes
- Anti-slip collar (*Martingale, Slip Collar, Dominant Dog Collar*)
- Toys, Treats, Tugs and Chews
- Training Tools (*Slip Lead, E-Collar, Long line, Clicker, Treat pouch*)
- Pet ID Tag with your contact number
- Registration tags with your city/municipality
- Calming lavender essential oils/balms applied to the baseboards (never directly on the animal)
- Music player (CD, Bluetooth etc.)
- A space on your couch and some free time to spend cuddling and relaxing with your new friend while they decompress



GIBSON'S LEGACY: ADOPTION TIPS FOR NEW OWNERS

- Welcoming Quiet Space

Help your new pal adjust to this major life-change with a quiet dim-lit room of their own for their first day or two.

- Blankets, toys, treats and tugs!

Toys, Chews and High Value Food/Treats can turn a cloudy day into a sunny one!

- Go for a walk!

Long walks are a great way to build a relationship with your new dog. If you or your new friend can't do long walks, short walks are good too!

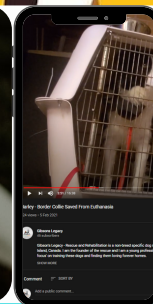
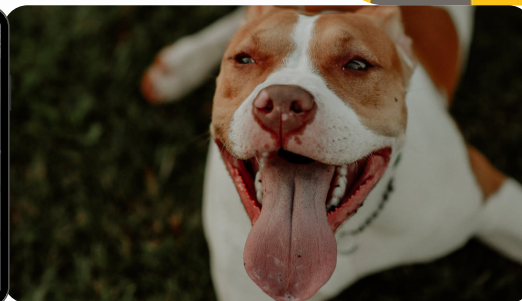
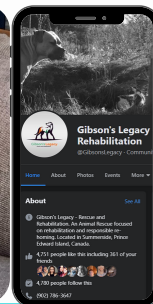
- Appropriate Kennel

Appropriate kennel to suit the specific needs of the dog. Wire kennel, plastic or x-pen.

3-3-3 Rule

ADOPTED DOGS take 3 days to decompress, 3 weeks to know your routine, 3 months to feel at home.

Give them a chance. Give them time.
